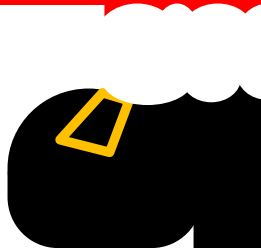


# CHALLENGE 9

## Make a Reindeer Antler Headband



There are lots of variations of ways to make a set of reindeer antlers.

Starting with a strip of card that circles the head you can then add the antlers of your choice. You can use the template and cut the antlers out of brown card, draw round hands or make from pipe cleaners.

Your class could get outdoors and hunt for antler shaped twigs and just hold them to the side of their heads to create a whole reindeer herd.

**You don't have to stick with headgear. Maybe make a mini reindeer from clay or one from a paper plate.**

### Reindeer facts

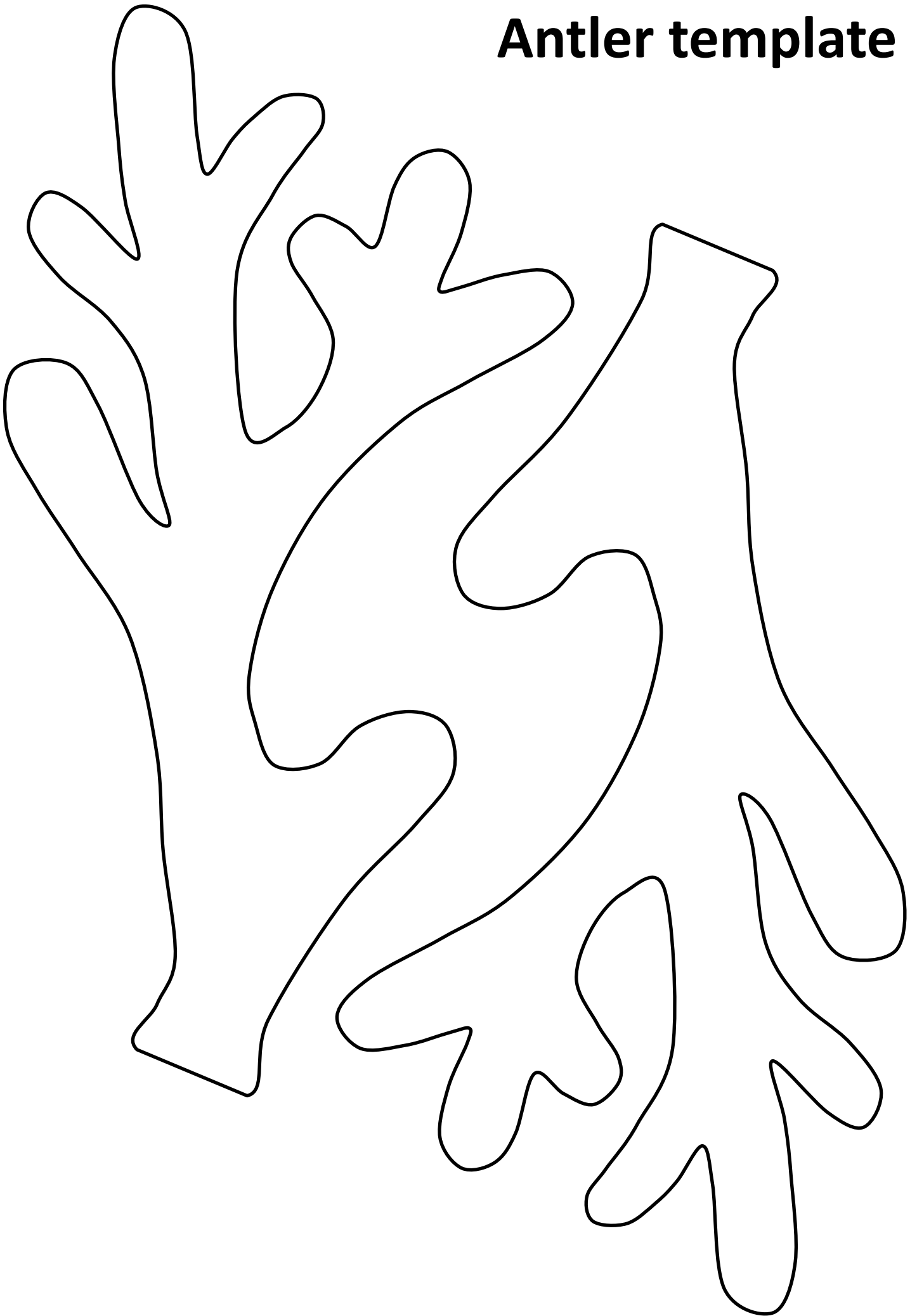
Reindeer are a species of deer. They are the only deer species in which both the male and female can grow antlers. In fact, males' antlers can grow up to a whopping 1.4 metres in length and have as many 44 points, called 'tines'.

Santa's reindeer travel a distance of over 41 million miles to deliver more than one million tonnes of presents at Christmas.

Santa's reindeer are named **Dasher, Dancer, Prancer, Vixen, Comet, Cupid, Donner, Blitzen, and Rudolph**
