**TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (FOOTPATH AUD/4, AUDENSHAW)
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER 2025**

Please notice that all representations sent in response to this Notice as public documents and may be viewed by anyone.

The above Order, made on 22 April 2025 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980, will extinguish the public footpath at the Rear of Brendon Drive & Brendon Bees Football Pitch, Audenshaw which runs from point A at Heron Drive (SJ91429837), in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 43 metres to point B (SJ91469839), then in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres to point C (SJ91479837), then in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 132 metres to point D (SJ91599833) and then in an easterly direction for a distance of 65 metres to point E (SJ91659834) to join Bridleway ASH/7, as shown by a bold line on the order map.

A copy of the Order and Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Audenshaw library, Ryecroft Hall, Manchester Road, Audenshaw, Manchester M34 5GJ during its normal opening hours. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there for £1.

This Order is made by Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (“the authority”) under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the 1981 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for Tameside require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the stopping up (as authorised by this Order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

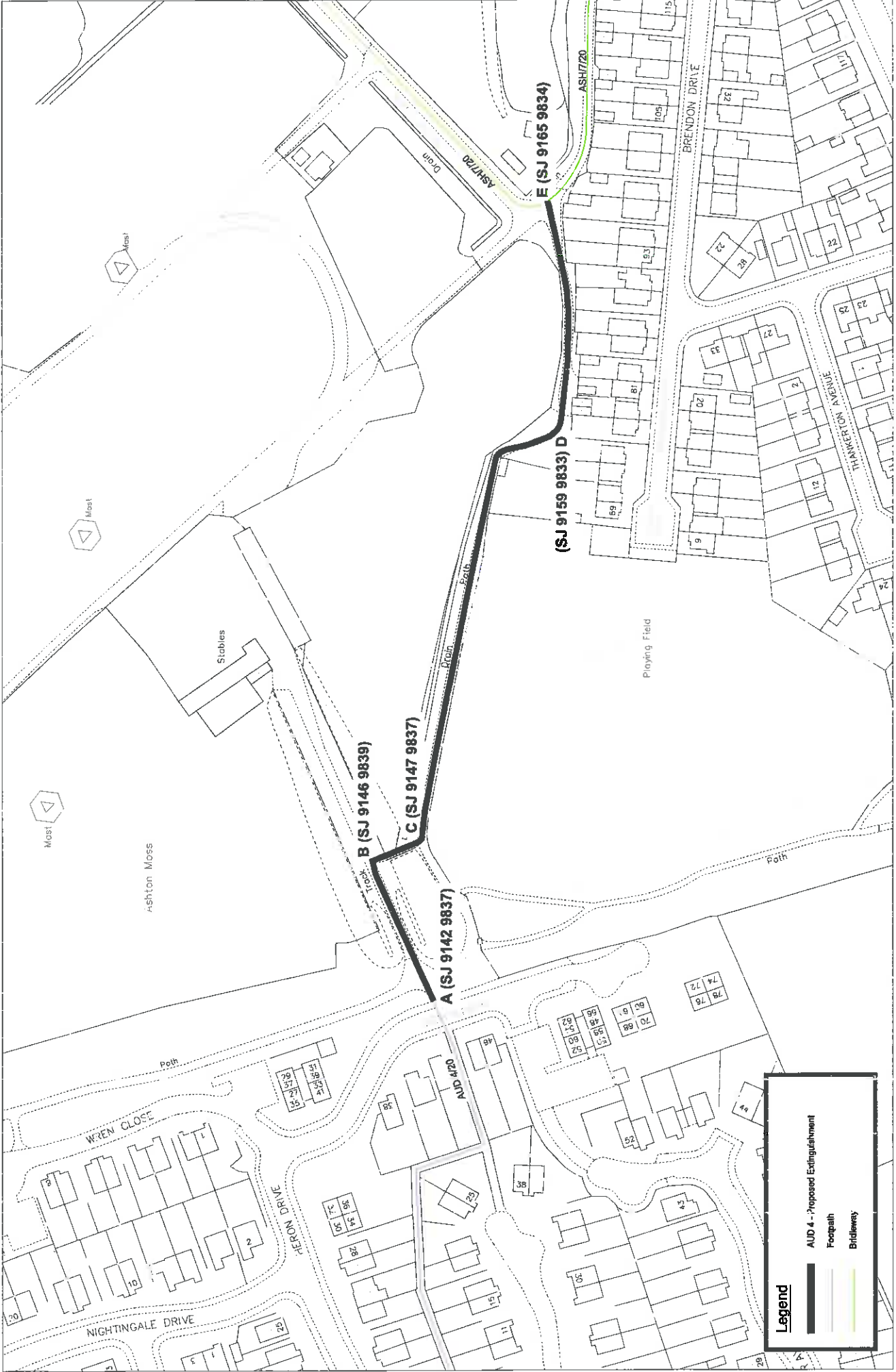
1. The public right of way over the land situated at the Rear of Brendon Drive & Brendon Bees Football Pitch shown by a continuous bold line on the map attached to this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of the order and thereupon the Definitive Map for Tameside shall be modified by removing from it that public right of way.
2. The Definitive Statement for Tameside shall be modified as described in Part 2 of the Schedule to the Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF EXTINGUISHED PATH

The full width of Footpath AUD/4 that runs from point A (SJ91429837), in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 43 metres to point B (SJ91469839), then in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres to point C (SJ91479837), then in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 132 metres to point D (SJ91599833) and then in an easterly direction for a distance of 65 metres to point E (SJ91659834) to join Bridleway ASH/7 as shown by a bold line on the order map.
