



NOTICE OF INTENT TO FELL STREET TREES

ENVIRONMENT ACT 2021

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 115, DUTY TO CONSULT

DATE OF NOTICE: 24th March 2025

Proposed street tree
removal outside: Hurst Knoll St James' C of E Primary School, Ashton OL6 8TR.

I give notice that Tameside Council intends to remove three street trees outside the above property.

Reason for intended removal: To create wider footways for shared pedestrians and cyclist use, and to provide access to and from a proposed new road crossing, which cannot be achieved with the tree(s) in situ.

Alternative options considered: The scheme will not be feasible without the removal of these trees. There are no alternative options. If the trees remain in place the footway width would not comply with current guidance for shared use.

Replacement tree proposal – Replacement trees to be planted in King Georges V Playing Fields in a future planting season.
