Hyde Leisure Centre

An out and back walk discovering the interesting things about Hyde. The walk is flat with no gradients on surfaced paths and is wheelchair accessible. There are plenty of seats along the route and toilet facilities at the leisure centre.

Beginners Walks: Hyde Leisure Centre

- Leave Hyde Leisure Centre and cross the car park, watching for traffic.
- Turn left onto Walker Lane and continue to Grange Road.
- Cross diagonally at the roundabout onto Walker Fold, taking care with traffic and go up the right hand side of Walker Fold to the corner at the top of Rufford Avenue.
- Go through the stile and follow the footpath between the fences to the main trail on the old railway line.
- Turn left here along the old railway line, keeping a look out for horses and cyclists.
- Continue straight on at the sign post after the bridge.
- Carry on to the end of the trail at the old locomotive turntable pit, and then retrace your steps back to Hyde Leisure Centre.
