No matters have come to our attention since 7 June 2024 that would have a material impact on the financial statements on which we gave our unqualified opinion.

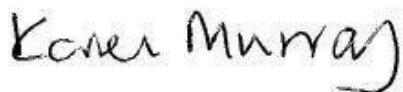
The Council's arrangements for securing economy, efficiency and effectiveness in its use of resources
