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Paying for Care

If you have been assessed as needing care and support, what you pay will depend on the care and support you need, who provides it and how often you need help.

Taking part in a financial assessment figures out the best way to pay for the care you need.



How do we work out what you pay?

During the financial assessment our Client Finance Team will look at your savings, assets, household costs and benefits to work out how much, if anything, you will have to pay towards the costs.

If you choose not to share your financial details with us, you will be asked to pay the full cost of your care and support.



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What will I need to complete a financial assessment?

- Copies of your most recent bank statements (3 months).
- Your National Insurance number.
- Details of any income, assets, and pension payments you receive.
- Details of essential expenditure, such as rent, mortgage, council tax and disability related expenditures.



What will I need to complete a financial assessment?

If you are completing this form on behalf of someone else, you will need to know their address, contact details and have their consent to contact us.

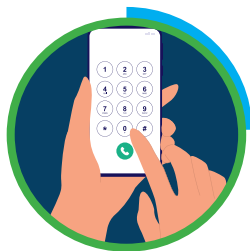
