# TAMESIDE IN PROFILE

In the Index of Multiple Deprivations (IMD) 2019, Tameside is ranked as the **28th** most deprived of **317** Local Authority districts in England and the **5th** most deprived in Greater Manchester.

**29** of the borough's **141** Lower Layer Super Output Areas (LSOAs) are in the most deprived **10%** of LSOAs nationally, **11** of these are in the most deprived **5%** nationally.

The IMD is made from a weighted combination of seven deprivation domains, of these domains in Greater Manchester we are (with 1 being the most deprived)

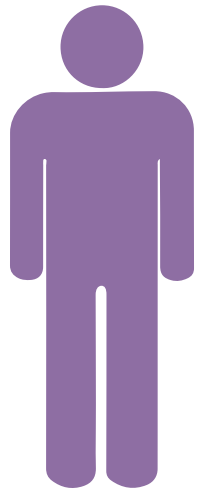

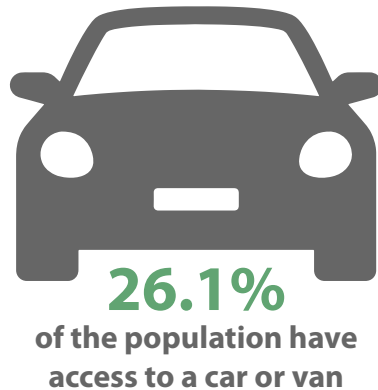

When residents were asked to score their lives from 0 (not at all happy) to 10 (Completely happy), Tameside scored a mean happiness rating of **7.13**



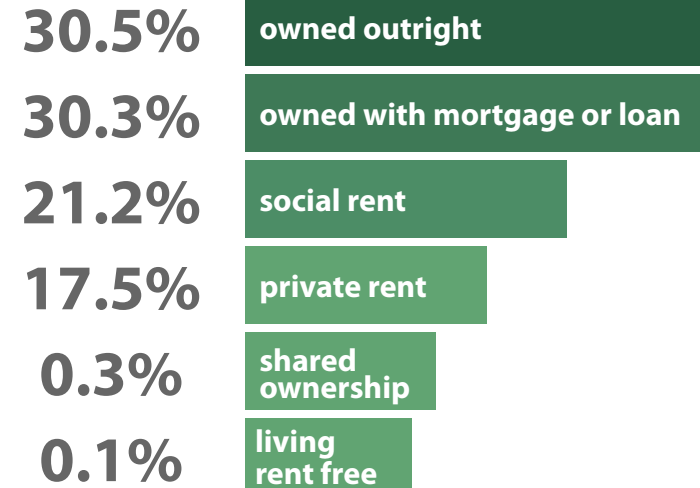

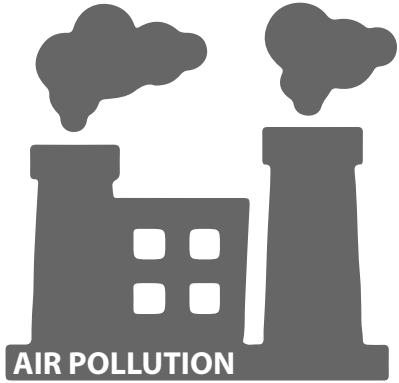

**AIR POLLUTION**

There are **7.67** micrograms per cubic metre of fine particulate matter pollution in the air, this is higher than the national average of **7.35**

Due to the small size of particulate matter, once inhaled, they can enter the bloodstream and prolonged exposure can lead to adverse health effects.



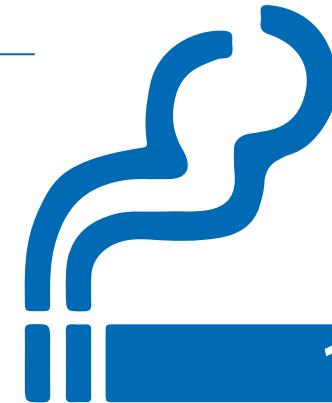
Tameside has an A&E, Urgent Treatment Centre, and 5 Primary Care Hubs

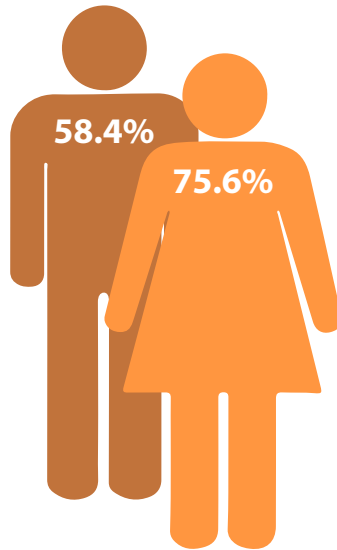

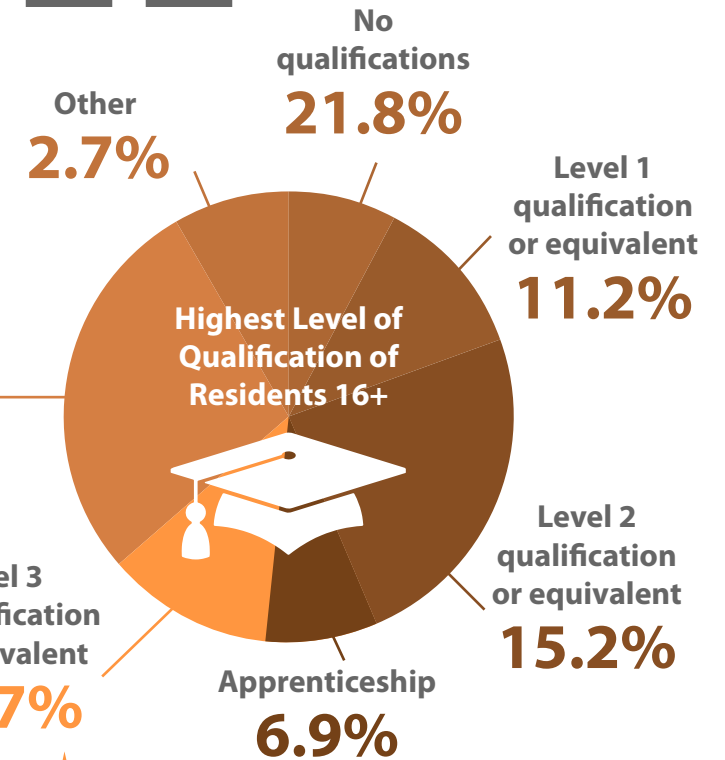
Tameside has **50** nurseries, **77** primary schools, **16** secondary schools, **8** special schools, and **4** colleges/sixth forms



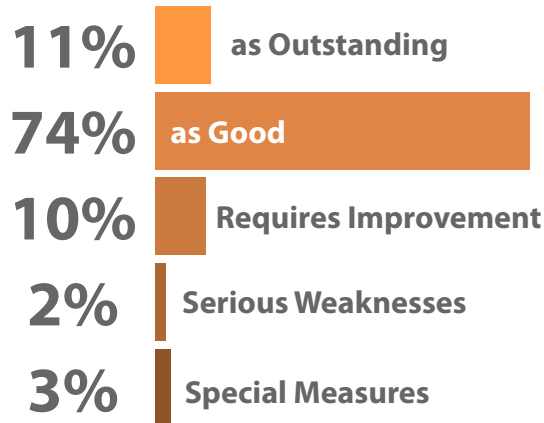
**66.9%** of children at the Early Years Foundation Stage (0-5) are achieving a good level of development
